Theresa M. Buchmiller, age 77 of Highland, IL, died Saturday, January 22, 2022, at Aviston Countryside Manor in Aviston, IL.

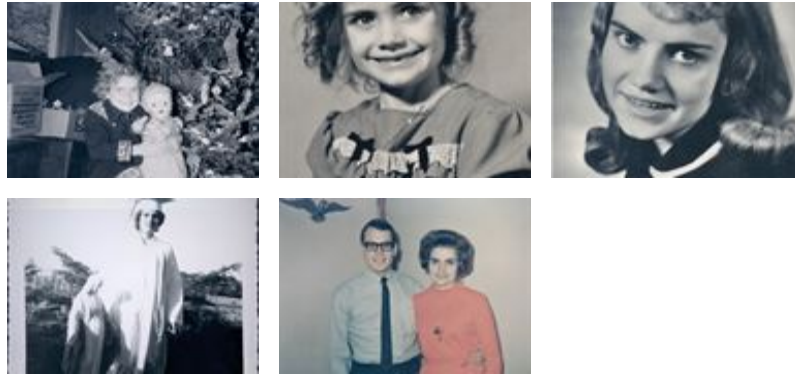
