Wayne A. Mollet, age 74 of Highland, IL, died Wednesday, May 11, 2022, at Alhambra Twp., IL.

He was born on Saturday, November 01, 1947, in Highland, IL, the son of Gerald and Edna (nee Gilomen) Mollet.

On Friday, February 14, 1975, he married Trudy A. (nee Neudecker) Mollet at Evangelical United Church of Christ, Highland, IL, who survives.

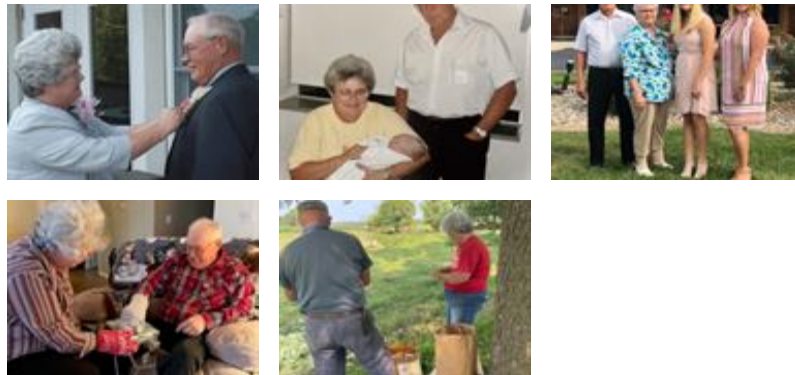
